STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Adjust the Standard Width Dimensions for Sawn Shingles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA \S 8826, sub- \S 2, first 2 sentences, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 545, \S 3, are amended to read:

The minimum width of the butt end of a shingle in the first 4 grades shall be $\frac{3 \cdot 1}{2}$ 3 inches and the maximum width shall be 12 inches. The minimum width of the butt end of a shingle in grade "utility" shall be $\frac{3}{2}$ inches and the maximum width shall be 12 inches.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this legislation is to adjust the dimension of shingles to a standard which is commercially acceptable. The marketplace is demanding that these new sizes and changes must be made to meet the competition if this industry is to remain competitive.
