## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 110TH LEGISLATURE FIRST REGULAR SESSION

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 21, L.D. 19, Bill,
"AN ACT to Amend the Maine Pesticide Control Act of 1975
to Fund Research Relating to Public Health."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in its place the following:

'The applicant desiring to register a pesticide shall pay an annual registration fee, except as otherwise provided in this subsection, of \$50-to-the-commissioner \$60 for each pesticide registered for such that applicant. Ten dollars of each \$60 shall be used for purposes of funding research, analysis and evaluation relating to public health concerns arising out of pesticide use. The annual registration fee is \$50 for any pesticide for which the applicant indicates, by affidavit or other method satisfactory to the department, that retail sales do not exceed \$6,000 per year in this State.'

## Statement of Fact

This amendment limits the fee increase to pesticides with sales greater than \$6,000 per year in this State. It is estimated that this will exclude roughly 100 pesticides of 3000 registered.
