STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing the Forfeiture for Drinking in Public.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

17 MRSA § 2003, sub-§ 1 is amended to read:

1. **Drinking in public place.** Any person taking a drink of liquor or offering a drink of liquor to another or any person in charge of a public place knowingly permitting drinking at or in a public place, except places licensed for on-premise sale of liquor, or any person taking a drink of liquor or offering a drink of liquor in any vehicle not licensed for sale of liquor shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$50 commits a civil violation for which a forfeiture of \$250 shall be adjudged.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill increases the penalty for drinking in public from \$50 to \$250.
