SENATE AMENDMENT "D" to H.P. 28, L.D. 32, Bill, "AN ACT Pertaining to Employment of Minors in Hotels and Motels."

Amend the Bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §664, last ¶, as amended by PL 1969, c. 504, §43, is further amended to read:

Employees who are under the age of 19 18 and are regularly enrolled in an educational institution or are on vacation therefrom may be paid a rate of not less than 75% 80% of the applicable minimum wage rate required for other employees in the same occupation.'

Further amend the Bill by renumbering sections 1 to 4 to be sections 2 to 5.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to adjust the wages which minors are paid.
