STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Establish a Standard of Type for Governmental Use to Assure Readability of Published Information.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

1 MRSA § 501-A, as amended by PL 1975, c. 746, § 1, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

Any such publication shall be printed using no less than 8-point type.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require state agencies and committees to use 8-point type in their publications. Five and 1/2-point and 6-point type are not adequate. Eight-point type is used by newspapers and is considered to be standard type throughout the country.
