COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 50, L.D. 114, Bill
"AN ACT Relating to the Licensing of Dealers in Certain
Agricultural Commodities."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "§452." in subsection 3 by striking out in the last 2 lines (same in L.D.) the underlined words "the state of his residence" and inserting in their place the underlined words 'another state'

Further amend the Bill in that part designated "§452." in subsection 6 in the last 2 lines (next to the last line in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "the state of his residence" and inserting in their place the underlined words 'another state'

Further amend the Bill in that part designated "§452." in subsection 7 in the first line (same in L.D.) by striking outthe underlined word and punctuation "apples,"

Further amend the Bill in that part designated "§458." by inserting at the end the following:

'3. Retailers. Any person who sells licensed commodities to consumers shall be exempt from this subchapter.'

Statement of Fact

The purposes of this amendment are to:

1. Clarify the definitions of broker and dealer; and

2. Remove the apple industry and retailers coverage under this bill.
