COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " $\mathcal{A}$ " to H.P. 96, L.D. 126, Bill, "AN ACT to Remove the Sunset Provision on the Regulation of Business Between Motion Picture Distributors and Exhibitors."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following:

'AN ACT to Extend the Sunset Provision on the Regulation of Business Between Motion Picture Distributors and Exhibitors.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

<u>'10 MRSA §1905</u>, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 266, is amended to read:

## §1905. Effective for 4 years

This chapter shall be effective for a period of  $\frac{2}{4}$  years from the effective date of the chapter.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to extend the sunset provision another 2 years.
