STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Increase the Licensing Fees for Chiropractors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

32 MRSA § 553, first sentence, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 65, § 1, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

Any person to whom a certificate has been granted under section 552 who wishes to renew that certificate shall, on or before the first day of June of each year, pay to the secretary of the board a license renewal fee not in excess of \$100 as established by the board. Upon payment of the fee that person's certificate shall be renewed for one year.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit the Board of Chiropractic Examination and Registration to increase license renewal fees from \$20 a year to \$50 a year and have the leeway to raise fees to \$100 should it become necessary in the future.
