### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Prohibit Campaigning Within 250 Feet of Voter Registration on Election Day.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

21 MRSA § 892, sub-§ 3, first sentence, as amended by PL 1977, c. 250, is further amended to read:

A person shall not display any advertising material or operate any advertising medium, including a sound amplification device, nor conduct campaign activity of any kind, intended to influence the opinion of any voter, within 250 feet of the entrance to the voting place or the place where voters are registering.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill prohibits campaigning within 250 feet of places where voters are registering. Currently that activity is prohibited within 250 feet of voting places.
