IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Set the Length Limit on Salmon in East Grand Lake at 16 Inches.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 7556-A is enacted to read:

§ 7556-A. Salmon; East Grand Lake

The minimum length for salmon on East Grand Lake is 16 inches.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill sets the length limit on salmon in East Grand Lake at 16 inches.
