STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Close the University of Maine on State Holidays.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

20 MRSA § 2257 is enacted to read:

§ 2257. Holidays

The following days shall be observed as holidays at the campuses of the University of Maine: The first day of January; Washington's Birthday, the 3rd Monday in February; Patriot's Day, the 3rd Monday in April; Memorial Day, the last Monday in May, but if the United States Government designates May 30th as the date for observance of Memorial Day or in 1985, whichever occurs first in time, the 30th of May; the 4th of July; Labor Day, the first Monday of September; Columbus Day, the 2nd Monday in October; Veterans' Day, the 11th of November; any day designated as the annual Thanksgiving; and Christmas Day, the 25th of December. No classes may be held on the above-named days.

When any one of these holidays falls on Sunday, the Monday following shall be observed as a holiday.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require the University of Maine to close on State holidays.
