HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 135, L.D. 162, Bill, "AN ACT to Permit Appointment of Deputies for the Purpose of Registering Voters Under the Election Laws."

Amend the Amendment in section 4 by striking out paragraph A and inserting in its place the following:

'A. A board of registration may appoint deputies only for the purpose of registering voters at the location where the board of registration meets.'
