HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 135, L.D. 162, Bill, "AN ACT to Permit Appointment of Deputies for the Purpose of Registering Voters Under the Election Laws."

Amend the amendment by striking out sections 1 through 4 and inserting in their place the following:

'Sec. 1. 21 MRSA §43, sub-§4, ¶A, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

A. A board of registration may appoint one or more

persons to act as deputies only for the purpose of registering voters at the location where the board of
registration meets.'

Further amend the amendment by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove the provision concerning appointment of the chairman of a board of registration, and to provide that deputies will register voters at the location where the board of registration meets.
