STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Increase the Compensation for the Board of Commissioners of the Profession of Pharmacy.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

32 MRSA § 2851, last \P , first sentence, as last amended by PL 1967, c. 390, § 16, is further amended to read:

The members of the board shall each receive as compensation for their services \$25 \$50 per day for the time actually spent and their necessary expenses incurred in the discharge of their duties.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill increases the compensation for members of the Board of Pharmacy from \$25 per day to \$50 per day.
