STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT Concerning Tax Exempt County Property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 36 MRSA § 652, sub-§ 1, ¶L, sub-¶ (2), div. (b) is enacted to read:

(b) Property owned by a county.

Sec. 2. 36 MRSA § 652, sub-§ 1, ¶L, sub-¶ (8) is enacted to read:

(8) Service charges imposed on county owned property may be deducted by the municipal officers from the tax imposed under section 254.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill permits a county shire town to impose service charges on county owned property. The service charges could be deducted from the county tax assessed against the town.
