HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 184, L.D. 199, Bill, "AN ACT to Increase the Licensing Fee for Games of Chance."

Amend the bill by striking ^{out} all of the title and inserting the following:
in its place/ 'AN ACT to Increase the Licensing Fee for Games of Chance and to Increase the Limit on the Amount that can be Gambled for any One Chance.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 2. 17 MRSA §341, as repealed and replaced by PL 1977, c. 350, §13, is amended to read:

§341. Limits on games of chance

A licensed game of chance shall be limited as to the amount to be gambled for any one chance to ~~25¢~~ 50¢, except that an organization may operate and conduct a game of cards and charge no more than \$1 daily entry fee for participation in a game of cards, provided that no money or valuable thing other than the \$1 daily entry fee is gambled in connection with a game of cards.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to increase the limit that
