SENATE AMENDMENT A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT A" to S.P. 92, L.D. 208, Bill, "AN ACT to Undedicate Funds Received from Public Reserved Lands."

Amend the amendment in section 2 by striking out the last 3 lines and inserting in their place the following:

'Any balance remaining shall-continue-from-year-to-year-as-a fund-available may be allocated by the Legislature on the recommendation of the legislative committee having jurisdiction over natural resources for the purposes set out in this section and for no other purpose.'

Further amend the amendment in section 5 by striking out the last 4 lines and inserting in their place the following:

'The Director of the Bureau of Public Lands may use such revenues recommendation of the as the Legislature on the/legislative committee having jurisdiction over natural resources may allocate from this fund for the purposes set forth in section 4162. These revenues shall be administered in accordance with Title 5, chapters 141 to 155.'
