STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Reimburse Certain Licensed Drivers who Paid a \$16 Fee During the Transition to the New License Fee System under the Motor Vehicle Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Reimbursement. Any person who was required to pay a fee of \$16 for a motor vehicle operator's license between July 1, 1980 and February 28, 1981 is entitled to a reimbursement of \$4.
- Sec. 2. Procedure. A person entitled to a reimbursement under section 1 of this Act may apply to the Secretary of State on a form to be designed and supplied by the Secretary of State. If the applicant proves that he is entitled, the Secretary of State shall certify the claim and the applicant shall be reimbursed. No claim may be paid unless it is filed on or before January 1, 1982.
- **Sec. 3. Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides for the reimbursement of \$4 to people who paid an additional \$4 amount for driver's licenses between July 1, 1980 and Feburary 28, 1981. The additional \$4 fee was part of a bill compensating for an expected shortfall in revenues to the Highway Fund.
