COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 103, L.D. 216, Bill, "AN ACT to Adopt a Lead Emission Standard under the Laws for Protection and Improvement of Air."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in its place the following:

'7. Lead. The maximum lead concentration at any location shall be 1.5 micrograms per cubic meter, measured by the arithmetic mean of daily 24-hour readings averaged over any calendar quarter.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment relaxes the standard in the bill to conform with the federal standard.
