COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" H.P. 165, L.D. 220, Bill,
"AN ACT to Amend the Law Relating to the Licensing of Privately-
owned Business, Trade and Technical Schools."

Amend the Bill in section 1 in that part designated "§2661"
by striking out subsection 2 and inserting in its place the
following:

'2. Exemptions. Schools of hairdressing and beauty
culture which are subject to approval of the State Board of
Cosmetology, educational programs related to the real estate
professions which are subject to approval under Title 32,
chapter 59, Real Estate Brokers and Salesmen, educational
programs offered by any Maine nonprofit corporation, any
educational programs offered by any professional or trade
association primarily for the benefit of its own members
and any institution authorized by the laws of this State
to grant a degree are exempt from the requirements of this
chapter.'

Fiscal Note

This bill will result in a revenue increase to the General
Fund of \$2,000.

Statement of Fact

This amendment would delete from the licensing require-
ment educational programs offered by any Maine nonprofit
corporation or any programs offered by any professional or
trade association primarily for the benefit of its members.
