HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 166, L.D. 230, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Clarify the School Construction Law."

Amend the Bill by inserting after section 2 the  
following:

'Sec. 3. 20 MRSA §3471, sub-§2, ¶E, sub-¶(5) is enacted  
to read:

(5) No article or ballot may include any  
suggestion to the voter as to how he should vote.'

Further amend the Bill by renumbering section 3 to  
be section 4.

Statement of Fact

This amendment forbids the practice of suggesting,  
in the article or ballot, which way the voter should vote on  
proposed school construction projects.
