SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 193,
L.D. 233, Bill, "AN ACT Pertaining to Public Safety on Public
Ways."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the first line
after the title and inserting in its place the following:

'Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out in the 3rd
line from the end (same in LD) the \leftarrow underlined words
"law enforcement" and inserting in their place the \rightarrow
underlined words 'public safety'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of sections 2,
4, 5 and 6.'


Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the
last 2 lines before the statement of fact and inserting in their
place the following:

'Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read
consecutively.'
