COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " $_{\rm A}$ " to S.P. 108, L.D. 238, Bill, "AN ACT to Define Alewives for the Purpose of Managing or Leasing Alewife Fishing Rights."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'12 MRSA §6001, sub-\$1-A is enacted to read:

1-A. Alewives. "Alewives" means the species Alosa pseudoharengus, commonly called alewife, and Alosa aestivalis, commonly called blueback herring.'

This amendment moves the definition to the general definition section of the Marine Resources laws.
