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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

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**AN ACT to Repeal Provisions for Premiums and Rebates under the Liquor Laws.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

28 MRSA § 305, as last amended by PL 1975, c. 741, § 17, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to repeal the provision for premiums and rebates under the liquor laws. This provision of law is considered unenforceable and unnecessary by those charged with enforcement.
