COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 236, L.D. 250, Bill
"AN ACT to Provide for the Termination of Cable Television
Permits Issued Prior to July 1, 1965 without Fixed Termination
Dates."

in paragraph J
Amend the Bill/at the end before the period by
inserting the following:

' , unless an earlier expiration date is mutually agreed upon
by the municipality and the permit holder. Any such cable
television system shall be constructed and operated in
accordance with Federal Communications Commission regulations.
These cable television systems, as a condition of franchise,
shall be operated in such a manner as to provide a safe,
adequate and reliable service to subscribers'

Statement of Fact

The amendment would allow an expiration date, by
mutual agreement, earlier than that specified in the bill,
15 years after the effective date.
