COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 244, L.D. 278, Bill,
"AN ACT to Increase the Amount of Expenses Which May be
Reimbursed to Members of the Inland Fisheries and Wildlife
Advisory Council.

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'12 MRSA §7033, sub-§3, as repealed and replaced by PL 1979, c. 543, §2, is amended to read:

3. Expenses. The members of the advisory council shall receive \$25 per day for their services and-the-council shall-be-allowed-actual-expenses-not-to-exceed-\$2,500-for-each fiscal-year.'

.Statement of Fact

This amendment deletes the maximum amount of expenses the Inland Fisheries and Wildlife Advisory Council may receive each year.
