SENATE AMENDMENT"A" to H.P. 244, L.D. 278, Bill, "AN ACT to Increase the Amount of Expenses Which May be Reimbursed to Members of the Inland Fisheries and Wildlife Advisory Council."

Amend the bill in the title by striking out the words "to Increase" and inserting in their place the following: 'Concerning'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in its place the following:

'3. Expenses. The members of the advisory council shall receive \$25-per-day-for-their-services-and-the-council-shall be allowed actual expenses not to exceed \$2,500 for each fiscal year.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove the \$25 per day allowance for members of the Wildlife Advisory Council and leave the existing \$2,500 limit as actual expenses that can be collected.
