**AN ACT to Permit More Frequent Accounting and Payment to the County
Treasurer of Fees Received by Register of Deeds.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

33 MRSA § 604, 2nd ¶, 3rd sentence is amended to read:

They shall account quarterly under oath, **and more frequently if desired**, to the county treasurers for all fees received by them or payable to them by virtue of the office, specifying the items, and shall pay the whole amount of the same to the treasurers of their respective counties quarterly on the 15th days of January, April, July and October of each year **and more frequently if desired**.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit register of deeds to account more frequently than quarterly to the county treasurer for fees received by the registers to pay those fees more frequently than quarterly, if desired.
