AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the Cumberland County Register of Deeds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA \S 2, sub- \S 1, \P C, sub- \P (6), as amended by PL 1979, c. 647, \S 2, is further amended to read:

(6) Register of deeds

11,316 13,500

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the salary of the Cumberland County Register of Deeds from \$11,316 to \$13,500. Because of the extensive responsibility placed on the register and in order to keep pace with the rapid rate of inflation, a salary increase is necessary.
