STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Remove the Limitation on Outside Earnings of Disability Retirement Allowance Recipients.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

5 MRSA § 1122, sub-§ 5, as last amended by PL 1979, c. 222, § 1, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Current recipients of disability retirement allowances have those allowances reduced if their outside earnings exceed \$10,000. This bill removes the restriction on outside earnings entirely.
