COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "8" to H.P. 280, L.D. 310, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Per Diem and Case Assignments for the State Board of Arbitration and Conciliation."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following:

'AN ACT Relating to the Per Diem for the State Board of Arbitration and Conciliation.'

Further / Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'26 MRSA §911, 5th sentence, as amended by PL 1969, c. 450, \$1, is further amended to read:

Members of the board shall each receive \$50 \$60 a day for their services for the time actually employed in the discharge of their official duties.

## fescal note

Since this amendment authorizes only one raise, rather than 2 consecutive raises as in the original bill, costs should remain at the \$1,030 annual level estimated for the first year of the original bill, and only \$1,200 for the 1982-1983 fiscal year. Appropriation for the original bill is contained in the Part II budget.

## Statement of Fact

This amendment would provide for only a single raise for board members. In addition, it removes section 2 of the bill, which is unworkable.
