STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Exempt Family Burying Grounds from Property Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

13 MRSA § 1142, first sentence is amended to read:

When a person appropriates for a family burying ground a piece of land containing not more than 1/4 of an acre, causes a description of it to be recorded in the registry of deeds of the same county or by the clerk of the town where it is situated and substantially marks the bounds thereof or encloses it with a fence, it shall be exempt from **taxation**, attachment and execution.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to extend to family burial grounds the same tax exemption which is currently available to public cemeteries.
