COMMITTEE AMENDMENT"A" to S.P. 140, L.D. 379, Bill, "AN ACT to Change the Requirements for Appointment to the Board of Commissioners of the Profession of Pharmacy."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'32 MRSA $\S2851$, 2nd \P , as amended by PL 1977, c. 231, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

Prior to appointing any pharmacist/member of the board,
the Governor shall solicit recommendations of candidates from
the Maine Pharmaceutical Association and other pharmaceutical
organizations as he deems appropriate.'

Statement of Fact

Presently, the Governor must make appointments to the pharmacy board from a list of candidates submitted by the Maine Pharmaceutical Association.

The purpose of this amendment is to require the Governor merely to consult with the Maine Pharmaceutical Association and other appropriate organizations before making appointments to the pharmacy board.
