COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" /H.P.313, L.D. 381, Bill, "AN ACT to Encourage the Establishment of Municipal Energy Commissions."

Amend the bill in that part designated "§3862." by striking out all of the 2nd line and inserting in its place the following:

'The purposes of the municipal energy commission may include the following:'

Further amend the bill in that part designated "§3862." by striking out at the end of subsection 5 the underlined word "and"

Further amend the bill in that part designated "§3862." by striking out the period at the end of subsection 6 and inserting in its place the following: '; and'

Further amend the bill in that part designated "§3862." by inserting after subsection 6 the following:

'7. Other purposes. To serve other purposes related to energy as specified by the municipality.'

The amendment clarifies the permissive rather than mandatory nature of this enabling legislation.
