STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Increase the Mileage Reimbursement Payment for Jurors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 14 MRSA § 1215, as enacted by PL 1971, c. 391, § 1, is amended to read:

§ 1215. Mileage and compensation of jurors

A juror shall be paid mileage at the rate of 10¢ per mile for his travel expenses from his residence to the place of holding court and return at the same rate per mile as that paid to state employees and shall be compensated at the rate of \$20 for each day of required attendance at sessions of the court.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
