Amend the bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following:

'AN ACT to Allow Wardens to Take a Cash Bond from any Person Found in Violation of the Fish and Wildlife Laws.'

in the first line of subparagraph (1)

Further amend the bill by striking out/the following

underlined words: "of any nonresident or alien"

Statement of Fact

This amendment extends the intent of the original bill to residents also. Current law treats residents and nonresidents alike. This bill, as amended, allows wardens to take a cash bond from residents and nonresidents in violation of fish and wildlife laws regardless of the proximity of the nearest District Court.
