STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Permit Hunting of Wild Game upon Certain Lands on Sunday.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. 12 MRSA § 7406, sub-§ 4, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 420, § 1, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
- 4. Hunting on Sunday. An individual properly licensed to hunt wild game in this State may, with the consent of a private landowner, hunt upon the land of that private landowner on certain Sundays for those species of wild birds and wild animals as permitted by state and federal rules and regulations.
 - Sec. 2. 12 MRSA § 7945, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 420, § 1, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to allow any properly licensed individual to hunt for wild game on certain Sundays upon his own land or such other private land as he is authorized to be upon.
