## AN ACT Relating to the Use of Snare Traps.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 7432, sub-§ 11, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 420, § 1, is repealed.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to remove from the prohibited devices' section of the fish and game laws that section which prohibits the use of snare traps. This would permit the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to authorize, by regulations, the use of snares as he deems appropriate.
