COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 401, L.D. 444, Bill, "AN ACT to Increase Job Security for Employees Elected to the Legislature, Excluding Employees Covered under Provisions Dealing with Teachers."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "§821." in the 7th line (6th line in L.D.) by striking out the underlined figure and word "10 days" and inserting in its place the underlined figure and word '60 days'

Further amend the Bill in that part designated "§824.", by striking out all of subsection 3.

at the end
Further amend the Bill by inserting before the Statement
of Fact the following:

'§825. Exception; small businesses

This subchapter is not applicable if the employer employs

5 or fewer persons immediately prior to the first day of the

leave of absence.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment extends the time limit within which the employee must give notice to his employer in order to be eligible for the protection afforded by the bill.

This amendment also makes clear that certain small businesses will not be governed by the bill.
