STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Increase the Fee for Serving Civil Process.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § **1051**, **sub-**§ **1**, as amended by PL 1977, c. **298**, § 1, is further amended to read:

1. Civil process. For service of all writs or complaints with summons, precepts, notices, executions, court orders, orders of service, copies and all other civil process or papers requiring service which are not specifically hereinafter enumerated, they shall receive therefor \$4 for each such service and \$7 \$10 if such service is required to be made in hand:

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the fee for serving civil process from \$7 to \$10.
