STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the Aroostook County Register of Probate.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. 30 MRSA \S 2, sub- \S 1, \P B, sub- \P (5), as last amended by PL 1979, c. 647, \S 1, is further amended to read:
 - (5) Register of probate $\frac{7,700}{10,400}$
 - Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act is retroactive to January 1, 1981.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the compensation of the Aroostook County Register of Probate in consideration of the increased duties and responsibilities of the register of probate under the Maine Uniform Probate Code. This will put the register of the 5th largest county at the average salary of the 15 other registers of probate. This bill is retroactive to January 1, 1981, the date the Maine Uniform Probate Code became effective.
