STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT Amending the Protection of Underground Facilities Statute.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

23 MRSA § 3360-A, sub-§ 2-A is enacted to read:

2-A. Underground facilities. All underground facilities shall have surface monumentation at all angle points or change of directions and as-built surveys shall be made of all underground facilities before back filling, with the surveys being made under the jurisdiction of a registered surveyor or survey engineer. All such surveys shall be recorded in the county registry of deeds where the real estate involved is located.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require underground facilities to have surface monumentation at all angle points or change of directions, and to require as-built surveys on all underground facilities before back filling, which surveys must be filed in the appropriate registry of deeds.
