HOUSE AMENDMENT" A" to H.P. 467, L.D. 519, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish Guidelines for the Issuance of Concealed Weapon Permits."

Amend the Bill in section 1 in that part designated

"§2031." in subsection 2 by striking out in the last line, after
the punctuation, the underlined word "or"

Further amend the Bill in section 1 in that part designated "\$2031." in subsection 3 in the last line by striking out the underlined word and punctuation "State." and inserting in its place the underlined words and punctuation 'State; or'

Further amend the Bill in section 1 in that part designated "§2031." by inserting after subsection 3 the following:

'4. Hunters and trappers. Hunters and trappers while in the act of hunting and trapping or while transporting a weapon to and from the hunting or trapping area, except that this subsection does not authorize the carrying of a weapon in violation of Title 12, section 7406.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to make it clear that hunters and trappers properly engaged in hunting and trapping

activities are exempt from the requirements of the concealed weapon statutes.
