STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend the Elderly Householders Tax and Rent Refund Act by Increasing the Income Limits.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

36 MRSA § 6108, as amended by PL 1977, c. 686, § 16, is further amended to read:

§ 6108. Income limitation

No claim otherwise allowable shall may be granted to claimants of single member households with household income in excess of \$5,000 \$7,000 in the year for which relief is requested; and no claim otherwise allowable shall be granted to claimants of households of 2 or more members with income in excess of \$6,000 \$8,000 in the year for which relief is requested.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill raises, by \$2,000 the income eligibility limits for claimants under the Elderly Householders Tax and Rent Refund Act.
