STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Abolish the Trapping of Bear.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. 12 MRSA § 7451, sub-§ 1, \P B, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 420, § 1, is repealed.
- Sec. 2. 12 MRSA \S 7452, sub- \S 2, as amended by PL 1979, c. 543, \S 38 is repealed.
 - Sec. 3. 12 MRSA § 7452, sub-§ 2-A is enacted to read:
- 2-A. Unlawful trapping of bear. A person is guilty, except as provided in subsection 15, paragraph A, of unlawful trapping of bear if he sets a bear trap.
- Sec. 4. 12 MRSA § 7452, sub-§ 15, \P A, as repealed and replaced by PL 1979, c. 723, § 18-B is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
 - A. Notwithstanding subsection 2-A, a person may use a cable trap with a closing diameter of not less than $2\,1/2$ inches or a culvert trap so constructed to enclose and hold a bear safely, or both, to trap bears in the State for the purposes described in sections 7502, 7504 and 7242;

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to prohibit the trapping of bear in this State.
