STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend the Workers' Compensation Act to Permit Rate Deductibles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

39 MRSA § 23, sub-§ 1, as last amended by PL 1977, c. 696, § 399, is further amended by adding a new sentence at the end to read:

Nothing in this Act forbids an insurance company from offering, or an employer from accepting, a workers' compensation insurance policy with terms requiring the employer to be a self-insurer under subsection 2 for the first \$1,000 of compensation and benefits payable under this Act.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill permits workers' compensation insurance policies requiring insurance coverage only after the first \$1,000 of compensation and benefits has been paid by the employer.
