IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Impose a Luxury Tax on Jewelry.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

36 MRSA § 1812-A is enacted to read:

§ 1812-A. Luxury tax on jewelry

In addition to the tax imposed by this chapter, a luxury tax of 10% of the sales price is imposed on the sale of all jewelry except wedding rings or engagement rings.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill creates an additional tax, over and above the sales tax, of 10% of the sales price of any jewelry, except wedding rings or engagement rings.
