STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend the Authority Governing License Fees of Victualers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 2754, last sentence, as amended by PL 1979, c. 562, § 14, is further amended to read:

Such ordinance or bylaw may, for the purpose of fixing such fees, establish classifications of victualers according to the size, nature or other condition of business conducted and may prescribe for such classifications an appropriate fee which shall not in any case exceed the sum of \$50 in towns of less than 10,000 population or the sum of \$100 in towns over 10,000 in population, excepting any town wherein a larger fee was permitted by law on July 20, 1939.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill permits the municipality to determine by ordinance the appropriate fee to be charged for victualer's licenses, as the cost of regulation exceeds the present statutory limitations.
