HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 605, L.D. 682, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify Certain Provisions of Law Relating to the Method of Voting for School Committee Members of the Wells-Ogunquit Community School District."

Amend the Bill by striking out the amending clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. P&SL 1979, c. 45, §6, 8th paragraph is amended to read:'

Further amend the Bill by adding at the end before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 2. P&SL 1979, c. 45, §6 is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

Any action taken by the school committee shall be by a vote of 60% of all 1,000 votes outstanding.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to restore a measure of balance to the voting weight of the Well-Ogunquit School Committee. The amendment preserves the right of the citizens to vote for their local school officials.
