## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES (Filing No. H-80) 110TH LEGISLATURE FIRST REGULAR SESSION

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " $\mathcal{A}$ " to H.P. 655, L.D. 758, Bill, "AN ACT to Increase the Compensation for Substitute Teachers."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'20 MRSA §1901, 3rd  $\P$ , as repealed and replaced by PL 1967, c. 462, is amended to read:

Substitute teachers with 4 years of study beyond the high school and with a bachelor's degree and in possession of a standard teachers' certificate and substitute teachers who have retired after a minimum of 15 years teaching shall be compensated at the rate of not less than \$20 \$30 for each day of service.'

## Statement of Fact

The amendment increases the minimum salary for substitute teachers from \$20 to \$30. The state minimum wage is \$3.35 per hour or \$26.80 for 8 hours.
